Mayor Schmitt called the meeting to order at 3:01 pm.

Mayor Schmitt took Roll Call.

Mayor Schmitt performed the first reading of the proposed ordinance, 6-2019.

Mayor Schmitt reviewed and discussed the proposed ordinance. He explained that Louisville Metro Council is voting on a tax increase. If that vote passes, Glenview Hills will raise taxes to equal the tax rate of Louisville Metro. If Glenview Hills does not raise its tax, the residents will still be paying Louisville Metro's tax increase, but with the difference of Louisville Metro and Glenview Hills going to Louisville Metro Revenue instead of Glenview Hills Revenue. He also explained what the Jefferson County League of Cities is advising and the ordinance the League has written. He noted that the ordinance has to be filed by the end of the week since Metro Council is voting on the tax increase. The Council discussed the ordinance as drafted. Attorney Wimberg has reviewed the ordinance and she made no changes. The Council made no changes as well.

Mayor Schmitt adjourned the meeting at 3:16 pm.

Mayor Schmitt called the meeting to order at 3:17 pm.

Mayor Schmitt took Roll Call.

Mayor Schmitt performed the second reading of the proposed ordinance, 6-2019.

Mayor Schmitt asked for any changes by the Council. The Council did not have any changes.

Commissioner Bentley made a motion to approve ordinance 6-2019. Commissioner Lawrence seconded the motion and Commissioner Green thirced the motion. The Council voted and ordinance 6-2019 passed unanimously.

Mayor Schmitt signed the ordinance. Clerk Schmitt witnessed the ordinance.

Mayor Schmitt adjourned the meeting at 3:20 pm.
