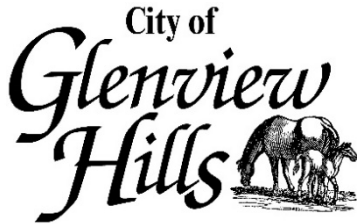

The meeting was called to order at 8:15am

City Attorney David Spendar discussed the Open Meetings Ordinance. Mayor Green read the first reading of the Open Meetings Ordinance. The council discussed a potential nuisance ordinance. Attorney Spendar outlined the requirements regarding code enforcement. The council discussed compiling an inventory of potential nuisance issues for review and assessment by Attorney Spendar. Mayor Green will solicit interest in the code enforcement board in the winter newsletter.

Commissioner White discussed the paving schedule. The council decided to request that Mr. Veeneman look at a 10-15 year paving cost analysis. Commissioner White will provide the most recent paving estimates to Mr. Veeneman.

The council discussed the Christmas lighting and agreed that there is a need for additional landscape lighting. Commissioner White offered to obtain a quote for entrance lighting. Mayor Green will also ask Dwyer for a quote.

Commissioner Wilson reported that the new entrance signs have been installed. Commissioner Wilson will request the final invoice. The council discussed replacing the stop sign on Glen Hill Road to a more aesthetically pleasing sign. Commissioner Wilson will look into options for the stop sign and a new soliciting sign to be installed on the back of the newsletter box.

Commissioner Bird questioned whether a resident may assist in managing the Flock cameras. Attorney Spenard advised that the city should not accept informal assistance outside of formal vendor or employee arrangements.

Mr. Veeneman presented the financial report and balance sheet.

The council will email Mayor Green with winter newsletter items.
